

WHAT TO DO IN AN ACCIDENT

If the accident is minor move your vehicle out of traffic and turn on your hazard lights. If anyone is injured or if another vehicle is involved, call 911.



It is required to call the police in some states. In Massachusetts and New Hampshire, it is required if there are minor injuries or damages exceed \$1000.

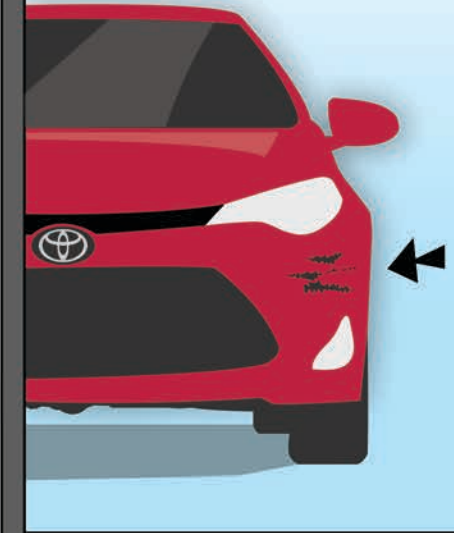
*If police can't come to the scene, you can file an accident report through your state's DMV

Exchange information with the other driver(s). See reverse side.

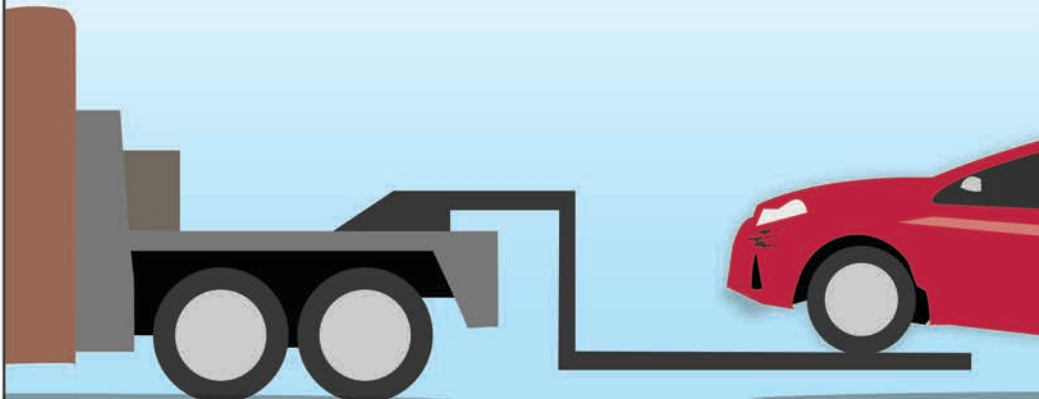


*do not sign any document unless it's for the police.
